Tournament Rules

- Games are to 25 (win by one) or 15 minutes; whichever comes first.
- Overtime play begins with a coin flip for first possession. First team to score wins the game.
- Must take ball back beyond the 3-point line (foul line in aux gym) for any change of possession.

Defense is not allowed when taking the ball back.

- Players may pass, dribble, or shoot after checking the ball up top to begin play.
- Fouls
 1. Shooting fouls on two-point shots result in the fouled player's team receiving 1 point and the fouled player taking 1 free throw.
 2. Shooting fouls on three-point shots result in the fouled player's team receiving 2 points and the fouled player taking 1 free throw.
 3. All "And-Ones" result in the team getting the value of the made shot PLUS one point. No free throws will be shot on And-Ones. Defense gets the ball up top.
 4. All non-shooting fouls before the fifth team foul will result in the ball being re-checked above the foul line. After the fifth team foul, the fouled player will be allowed to shoot one free throw for two points.
 5. In the last minute, all non-shooting fouls are one free throw for two points. The clock does not stop.
- Free throw line distance: 5th-10th grade – 15 feet

Late Game Rules

1. In OT, no points awarded for shooting fouls. Regular basketball scoring rules.
