The Juilfs Foundation, through its generous gifts, has made this 28-acre park a crown jewel of the Anderson Parks. Park visitors of all ages can get out and get active with lots of fun outdoor activity options, including a hike/bike trail, a farm-themed playground, two sand volleyball courts, three tennis courts, one basketball court, two picnic shelters, three ball diamonds and lots of open space. The picnic shelters and seasonal ball diamonds and soccer fields are reserveable. The popular one mile paved hike/bike trail winds throughout the park. Picnic tables, family swings and park benches are also sprinkled throughout the grounds. Restrooms are located on the backside of the office building. Juilfs Park is also the most popular location for items purchased from the park district's Lasting Gifts program, including adopted trees, benches and the "Apple of Your Eye" Tribute Tree.
