### About Veterans Park:

Originally known as Forest Park, the 13.1 acres for Veterans Park was purchased in 1978. The Park received a 'face lift' in 1997, made possible by a NatureWorks grant awarded in 1996. The Park was re-dedicated on Veterans Day, November 11, 1997 to all Anderson residents who served in the US armed services. Veterans Park features the "Lucky Lanier All-Children's Playground" designed with the physically challenged child in mind. A large reservable shelter sits beside the playground, while a .4 mile jogging trail encircles the entire park. This park also sports a ball diamond, soccer fields, a basketball court and small reservable shelter with a fire ring (permit required) and restroom facility.
