Attending this event will provide an opportunity for residents, trail users, and families to learn more, ask questions, and contribute feedback.

CORA, in partnership with Anderson Park District, is set on a mission to integrate a network of trails throughout Great Parks of Hamilton County, Cincinnati Parks, Cincinnati Recreation Commission, Anderson Park District, Anderson Township, and the City of Newton. Clear Creek Bike Park will become the heart of the Little Miami River Valley Outdoor Recreation Corridor, which will connect hundreds of miles of paved bike trails together.
