## SAFETY IN YOUR PARKS

The Anderson Park District strives to provide our community with clean and safe parks. Anderson is fortunate to have a park system with convenient connections to neighborhoods and schools making it easy to access and enjoy parks throughout the community. Seeing the parks busy with walkers, runners and bike riders of all ages demonstrates how this community values spaces for public recreation. As you enjoy your parks, please be aware of your surroundings and help keep the parks safe by following the Park District's rules and general safety guidelines.

Anderson Parks' *Rules and Regulations* may be found in park bulletin boards or by visiting the Permits, Rules & Regulations page at [AndersonParks.com](http://AndersonParks.com). Park District employees and the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office enforce these rules to help keep parks safe and enjoyable for all visitors. Violations may result in a ticket and fine. (Section 21. Enforcement/Penalty)

**General safety tips to help keep the parks safe and enjoyable for everyone:**

### E-BIKES & E-SCOOTERS

(Section 11. A (1), Traffic)

Electric bikes and electric scooters have become very popular over the past year. Although they are a great mode of transportation, patrons are asked to power down their electric bikes/scooters and pedal manually while on park trails.

Please remember bicycles, scooters, skateboards, electric motorcycles and electric dirt bikes are prohibited on park fields, playgrounds or in shelters. Electric motorcycles and electric dirt bikes are considered motor vehicles and prohibited outside of designated parking areas.

### DOG POLICIES

(Section 18. A (2) and (7) Domestic Animals)

**Leash Law:** While walking your dog in public, they must remain on a leash, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 955.22. A leash no longer than six (6) feet in length is required at all times. If you prefer to exercise your dog off leash, contact the park office for information on the Kellogg Dog Field.

**Dog Waste:** Please be a responsible pet owner while visiting the parks. Dog waste is considered litter. Always clean up after your dog and dispose of waste properly.

**Pet Free Events:** For people, and pet safety, some APD events do not allow pets. Large crowds, especially with children, and multiple dogs can create safety concerns and unintended interactions.

### DRIVING IN THE PARK

Drive through the parks as you would on public roads. Obey posted speed limits, stop at all stop signs, and do not drive or park on the grass.

Help prevent theft by leaving valuables at home and always remember to lock your vehicle!
